# Tiburón Explorer

The unique and spacious *Tiburón Explorer* motor yacht is specifically designed and being built to cruise through the Galapagos. You will dine on fine cuisine and relax in one of the many spacious areas throughout your cruise. The vessel accommodates 16 guests in 9 air-conditioned twin/queen staterooms, all with private bath and showers. Cabins are located on the main and lower decks with windows maximizing your views of the Pacific Ocean. The air-conditioned salon on the main deck offers tables for dining and TV/lounge area. Sunning areas with ample seating and a hot tub are located on the top deck.

The dive deck is equipped with individual gear bins, camera table, recharging station, air and Nitrox filling stations, tank racks and a separate fresh water rinse tank for underwater camera equipment. Diving operations are conducted from two large pangas (tenders), easily boarded from the dive deck.



**Itineraries:** 8 days/7 nights; up to 4 dives per day (up to 18-19 total)

**Accommodations:** 16 guests in 9 air-conditioned double staterooms, each with private bathroom and shower, all with large window ocean views

**Departs:** Baltra each Saturday

**Length:** 125 feet; 24.6-foot beam

**Max Speed:** 10 knots

**Diving Conditions:** Coldwater diving. Water temperatures range from 65-75°F/18-24°C from Dec-May and 60-70°F/16-21° Jun-Dec; all diving is done directly from pangas (dive tenders); Nitrox available
